The Abundant Gifts catalog offers a way to make an impact on the lives of people who have not had the opportunities we have had, while also offering a way to show our love and appreciation for family and friends without lavishing gifts on them that they don't really want or need. Read below about our outreach partners and ministries, then choose the ones you want to support with your contributions.

Church of the Good Shepherd Snack Bags

Providing food for our neighbors in need is a significant aspect of Good Shepherd's outreach ministries, and every day of the week the church gives out snack bags to 30 - 40 members of our community who are hungry. These bags contain water, crackers, sausages, and applesauce – a little something to tide people over lunchtime.

Good Shepherd Day School

Good Shepherd Day School is a five-star state-accredited day care center that serves a diverse population. Starting at six weeks of age, an average of 50 children spend their day in a structured environment full of love and care. The school is staffed by more than 12 early childhood care professionals who intellectually and emotionally nourish the children until they are ready to leave for Kindergarten.

Roughly one half of the families at Good Shepherd Day School receive scholarships through various organizations, including Edgecombe and Nash County Social Services.

United Community Ministries

United Community Ministries has been addressing the needs of the homeless in Nash and Edgecombe counties ever since it was founded at Good Shepherd in 1977. Their goal is to provide a nurturing and supportive environment to those without a home as they move toward wholeness.

A significant part of United Community Ministries is the Community Shelter, which offers services such as assessment, referrals, counseling and employment

assistance to homeless and food insecure individuals. In addition, the adjoining Community Kitchen and Pantry serves meals and helps families in need with food baskets, and the Bassett Center provides outreach services for homeless and nearly homeless families and children.

Down East Partnership for Children

Incorporated in 1993, the Down East Partnership for Children was established when a group of citizens and leaders from Nash and Edgecombe counties came together to address the needs of children and families in our communities. Its mission is to launch every child as a healthy, lifelong learner by the end of the third grade while promoting the belief that all children and families can reach their full potential when surrounded by a united and supportive community.

DEPC strategically invests approximately \$7 million yearly into the education system that supports children 0-8 and their families. This investment supports programs at DEPC and in partnering agencies throughout Nash and Edgecombe counties.

Conetoe Family Life Center

The mission of the Conetoe Family Life Center, established in 2007, is to improve the health of the youth and community by offering greater availability of healthy foods, increasing physical activities, and providing access to health services. Through these activities, the Conetoe Family Life Center aims to alter the poverty cycle in families.

My Sister's House

The journey of growing from a victim into a survivor can be very hectic, tiring, and demoralizing, and My Sister's House has been providing support since 1981 to victims of domestic violence in Nash and Edgecombe Counties as they navigate that process. Through its safe house and its offices in Nashville, Tarboro, and Rocky Mount, the agency offers a sexual assault program and a Latino outreach program, various support groups, and assistance with judicial proceedings (ex parte orders, warrants, permanent order hearings, and bond settings).
